DISCUSSION & PRAYER ([PHILIPPIANS 4:6-7](#))

What challenge are you facing?

SCRIPTURE

[2 Timothy 1:7](#)

(Read this passage on your own and aloud as a group.)

REFLECTION

1. Think about the political ads you have seen lately. Most of them have a negative tone, right? Why do you think that is? How do you think all of that negativity affects people?
2. Sometimes people respond to fear and pain in their own lives by trying to gain power and control over other people. How do you think that kind of power is different from the power Paul is talking about in the passage above?

APPLICATION

1. List as many aspects of Christ's character as you can. Check your list against the virtues in [1 Corinthians 13:4-7](#) and [Galatians 5:22-23](#). When responding to problems in the world, why is it important to focus on having a Christ-like character first?
2. What do people mean when they say, "The ends justify the means"? How might that approach to the world's problems affect someone's opportunity to be a witness to people who are disconnected from Christ?
3. "Perfect love expels all fear" ([1 John 4:18](#)). What is an example of a fear you have been holding onto that needs to be expelled by love? (It doesn't have to be related to the election.)
