1. What stands out to you from the Scriptures you just read?

APPLICATION

1. What will you do to put on the full armor of God this week?
2. Practicing evangelical Christians are people who value Scripture, keep Christ central, share Him with others, and let their faith guide their lives. About 80% of white evangelicals tend to vote Republican. About 80% of black evangelicals tend to vote Democrat. Do these two groups have to agree on politics in order to be united by Christ? Why or why not?
3. What can we say in response to a Christian brother or sister who “saw a YouTube video” about a conspiracy that sounds like a clever lie ([Ephesians 4:14-15](#))?
