**Key Idea:** Functional Kingdom living looks upside-down when compared to the kingdoms of the world.

## DISCUSSION & PRAYER (PHILIPPIANS 4:6-7)

*What has God done that you are thankful for this week?*

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*What are you worried about?*

## SCRIPTURE

**Matthew 5:43-48**

(Read this chapter on your own and aloud as a group.)

REFLECTION

Who might be considered enemies of Christians today?

What would it look like for Christians to love them?

## APPLICATION

*If choosing to love (Greek: agape/agapao) your enemies makes you more perfect (functional, mature, Greek: teleios), who do you need to be praying for regularly? (Be careful to share your answer with your group only if you can do so in a humble way that does not spread gossip or slander.)*

*“So that” are two words that help us add purpose to our prayers. Write a short prayer for someone who has wronged you in some way, and include a “so that” statement that honors God. Read [John 17:21](#) and [Ephesians 1:18](#) for examples.*

**NOTE:** It’s the second week of Small Group! Use the [Small Group Covenant](#) as a guide to help set expectations for your group. Also start thinking about planning a service project that reaches outside the church, and a social that helps build relationships within your group.
