REFLECTION & APPLICATION

1. What stands out to you from this passage?
2. It seems likely that at least some of the people shouting, “Hosanna (God saves),” were shouting “Crucify Him!” within the week. How/why do you think people’s positions changed so dramatically?
3. Most people in Jesus’ time expected the Messiah to reign from a throne: the Heir of David ([Isaiah 11:10](#)) and the Lion of Judah ([Genesis 49:9-10](#)). Instead, He hung from a cross: the Suffering Servant ([Isaiah 53:3-6](#)) and the Lamb Who was Slain ([Isaiah 53:7-9](#)). How has your experience with Jesus been different from what you might have expected?
