Key Idea: Let God turn your wounds and weakness into His redemptive work.

DISCUSSION & PRAYER (PHILIPPIANS 4:6-7)

What has God done that you are thankful for this week?

What are you worried about?

SCRIPTURE

[2 Corinthians 12:6-10](#)

(Read this chapter on your own and aloud as a group.)

REFLECTION

There is a saying, “Hurt people hurt people,” meaning that someone who hurts others may do so because of a hurt they themselves have experienced. Why do you think that is?

Paul’s account from 2 Corinthians 12 is one of many examples of God not taking away a difficulty, but instead giving strength to endure it. When is a time you had to rely on God’s grace to get you through something?

APPLICATION

A variety of at-risk, sinful behaviors can be linked to adverse childhood experiences (ACEs), which affect over half the adults in Wisconsin. How is this knowledge useful to disciples of Jesus?

We often pray for friends and family when they have a sickness or injury. Why? What is a “so that” statement that could tie our prayers to honoring God? (See [2 Corinthians 1:4](#), [John 20:30-31](#) for ideas.)
