DISCUSSION & PRAYER (PHILIPPIANS 4:6-7)

SCRIPTURE

[Revelation 9:13-21](#)

(Read this chapter on your own and aloud as a group.)

REFLECTION

Now we're in the sixth trumpet within the seventh seal of Revelation, and God has released powers that destroy one third of all the people set against Him. Since God loves the world ([John 3:16](#), [2 Peter 3:9](#)), how do you make sense of this violence?

Read [Luke 18:9-14](#). Do you think most Americans perceive people in the church more like the first person in the parable or the second person? Why is that?

APPLICATION

What can you do to be more like the tax collector and less like the Pharisee from the parable above?

Last week you were asked to identify one measurable step you are willing to take between now and Easter (April 17) to address a good thing that is threatening to become a "god thing" (an idol) in your life. How is that going?
