REFLECTION

Read 1 Corinthians 13:4–7, inserting “a Christian” into the blanks.

“\_\_\_\_\_ is patient and kind. \_\_\_\_\_ is not jealous or boastful or proud or rude. \_\_\_\_\_ does not demand [their] own way. \_\_\_\_\_ is not irritable, and \_\_\_\_\_ keeps no record of being wronged. \_\_\_\_\_ does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out. \_\_\_\_\_ never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance.”
