DISCUSSION & PRAYER ([PHILIPPIANS 4:6-7](#))

(Read this passage on your own and aloud as a group. It's a long one; consider sharing the reading responsibilities.)

REFLECTION

1. What stands out to you about how God began forming the Philippian church in Acts 16?
2. Not everyone is gifted by God to be apostolic ("sent") catalysts like Paul and Silas. How do you think the Good News of Jesus spread in Philippi after Paul and Silas left?

APPLICATION

1. Think about people where you live, work, play and shop who are disconnected from Christ and/or the church. What difference does it make whether they know Him or not?
2. What do you think might make a disconnected person resistant to a conversation about Jesus?
3. It's not our job to control and convince people. When you consider how God opened doors (literally and figuratively) in Philippi, how will you pray for Him to be involved in your sphere of influence?
