REFLECTION *Listening for God*

- 1. Master of More versus Master of Mercy:** Scripture is full of warnings about money and accumulation. When rich people are mentioned positively in the New Testament, they are giving ([Mt 27:57-60](#); [Lk 7:4-5](#); [19:1-10](#); [Ac 10:2; 16:14-15](#); [1 Ti 6:17-19](#); [He 7:1-2](#)). In what ways is God a giver?
- 2. Two Kinds of Running:** Read [Hebrews 12:1-3](#) (about endurance) and [Matthew 11:28-30](#) (about rest). How is the exhaustion of trying to earn security (Mammon) different from the endurance of following Jesus? How is it possible to work hard while still having a restful soul?

APPLICATION *Following Him*

- 1. Shifting Our Focus:** Regarding wealth, if we try to put a specific amount on “How much is too much?” the answer is usually, “Definitely more than what I currently have.” Why is it important to focus on attitudes about wealth rather than amounts ([1 Timothy 6:6-8](#); [Hebrews 13:5-6](#))?
- 2. Un-“stuff”-ing:** Are there things you’re hanging on to that you could give away (and probably not notice they were gone)? What things? How could de-cluttering your life help free you from slavery to Mammon?
