SCRIPTURE

REFLECTION

1. What is the mission of Jesus as you understand it? (See a few insights from Scripture in [Luke 4:17-21](#), [19:10](#); [John 3:16-17](#); [1 Corinthians 5:19-21](#); [Galatians 1:4](#); [1 John 3:8](#).)
2. How is your church equipping you to be a person who joins Jesus in His mission?

APPLICATION

1. “Religious people have preferences; missional people have stories.” If you have one, share a recent story of obeying God’s lead to join Jesus on His mission (even when it wasn’t your preference). If you don’t have a recent story, why do you think that is?
2. Paul instructs us in the inspiration of the Holy Spirit to, “Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace” (Ephesians 4:3). What effort are you willing to make to strengthen unity with someone in the church?
