REFLECTION

1. How do you think the Pharisees and teachers of religious law expected Jesus to respond to their question in verse 5?
2. What does this passage teach us about God?

APPLICATION

1. When is a time that you felt pressured to choose between two options when neither one seemed exactly right?
2. Think of an issue or a policy or a politician you feel strongly about. Are you able to understand how someone could come to a different conclusion? What would it look like for you to love that person while still disagreeing with them?
3. Jesus didn't tell us to build alliances and make laws; He told us to love our enemies and make disciples. How have you made progress in living out those instructions since the last presidential election?
