REFLECTION *Listening for God*

- 1. Us vs. Them:** “Tribalism” is the strong loyalty, identification, and allegiance to a specific social group, often characterized by an “us vs. them” mentality. How does tribalism make us feel like we are on the narrow road when we might actually be on a crowded highway?
- 2. The Heart vs. the Appearance:** Jesus contrasts outward religious appearance with inner transformation. Why is it easier to rally against a social enemy than to deal with the sin inside our own hearts?

APPLICATION *Following Him*

- 1. One by One:** How does the discipleship rhythm of “Reflection, Application, and Discussion” help you focus on your personal transformation rather than just getting caught up in a congregational experience?
- 2. Yielding Advantage:** The narrow path involves yielding our advantage in order to show mercy. Can you identify a recent situation where you had the right to be defensive, but chose the narrow path of gentleness instead?
